In undertaking checks at the Acceptance stage, the Inspectorate has made some initial observations in relation to the application. This letter comprises advice to the Applicant provided under section 51 of the PA2008 in respect of those initial observations. The Applicant should pay attention to its content, and consider how appropriate action might be taken in response. It should be read in conjunction with the Tees CCPP s55 Acceptance of Applications checklist (the Checklist) issued alongside it.

## Plans and drawings

Works Plan (Document 4.3) Sheet 1 identifies Works No. 2A in the Key but no description is provided, unlike for Works No.2B. For consistency a description should be provided.

Works Plan (Document 4.5) Sheet 3 which provides elevational drawings does not include a scale bar unlike the plan drawing at Sheet 2 of 3. Whilst Sheet 2 of Document 4.5 would become a certified document should the DCO be made and Sheet 3 would not be certified. Therefore, a scale bar on Sheet 3 would be helpful.



Application Documents 4.12 and 4.13 have been produced on an aerial photo base. It would be helpful to the Examining Authority if these plans could also be provided on an Ordnance Survey base.

As the published Checklist sets out, it appears on the basis of the information provided by the Applicant that the potentially relevant bodies listed below were not consulted at the pre-application stage:

- Southern Gas Networks Plc
- Utility Distribution Networks Ltd

Unless there is a good reason in each case on the basis of which the Applicant is confident that these bodies are not relevant to the proposed development, the Applicant is advised to include these bodies, or their appropriate successors, in its s56 notification exercise.
