Further to our meeting on Thursday I thought I would confirm the actions that we were agreed at the meeting.

- Lazenby noise measurement data post power station closure will be used in any assessment for ERM to demonstrate compliance with BS4142:2014; and to be used to establish baseline levels.
- will carry out monitoring in Grangetown between 12:00 and 03:30 and carry out a minimum of 30 min measurements (weather conditions suitable) on 3 separate occasions and he can demonstrate this is appropriate in compliance with BS4142:2014 and to be used to establish baseline levels.
- A continuous monitor will be placed on the proposed development site to act as a surrogate monitor and calculate likely levels at the nearest sensitive site in Grangetown. – This will also provide current site levels
- will arrange for analysts to carry out monitoring of 7 locations, as identified on the site's permit on 1 occasion using a Class 1 meter to be used to establish baseline levels.

I am aware that Geoff has carried out some measurements over the weekend and has provided initial measurements.
