I request to join both the Preliminary Meeting and the Issue Specific Hearing (ISH1) on 10th May.

At the preliminary meeting, I wish to speak at Item 3 on the "Initial Assessment of Principal Issues". I wish to speak briefly on "potential cumulative and in-combination impacts" of greenhouse gas emissions from construction and operation, and how they may be dealt with under item 3 "Climate Change" in the context of the requirements of the EIA Regulations. And on the issue "Emissions of greenhouse gases arising from the development, including during its operational phase", how may fuel supply chain greenhouse gas emissions (eg methane leakage emissions from fuel extraction) be dealt with in assessing the greenhouse gas emissions associated with the scheme.

At the Issue Specific Hearing (ISH1), I wish to speak briefly on:

- fuel supply chain greenhouse gas emissions (eg methane leakage emissions from fuel extraction) in assessing the greenhouse gas emissions associated with the scheme in the context of the scope of the Proposed Development;
- the latest scientific evidence relating to carbon capture and storage (CCS), its viability as a decarbonisation policy delivery method, and its socio-economic impacts, including air quality and health, and the potential for inquisitorial investigation of this evidence during the examination in the context of the scope of the Proposed Development, and the policy and legislative frameworks.
