Thank you for your letter in respect of the above proposal which we received on 23 November 2017. We have no objection to the application as submitted. However, we have the following comments to make.

#### Marine

We accept the proposed variation to increase the dredge depth from 6.5m to 8.5m, only within the wet dock adjacent to berths 8 and 9.

We consider that condition 5.2.3 can be exempt from the wet dock adjacent to berths 8 and 9 only. We wish to note that conditions will continue to remain in place for all of the remaining dredge areas covered by this licence.

Please note, any permanently wetted areas of dock have the potential to contain European Eel. These species are protected under the Eel (England and Wales) Regulations 2009, and any activities within a confined dock area, that may kill or damage eels must be avoided.
